

## ✳ **HomeEd2010**

This is our tenth conference and once again it offers you an opportunity to meet many other Christians who have taken up the God given challenge to bring their children up 'in the training and instruction of the Lord'. The whole conference centre has been booked for the week so that up to 60 families can, if they wish, stay on beyond the conference but booking for the holiday week must be done separately (see the enclosed sheet). The HomeEd2010 conference is **half board** enabling us keep our costs down - still no more than that of 2002 in spite of a big increase in Cefn Lea prices.

## ✳ **Programme**

The programme includes our usual mixture of informative talks and seminars but also allows plenty of time in between for you to meet like minded people or to enjoy the surrounding countryside.

As usual the seminars and workshops will cover a wide range of topics, some for those just starting out, others for those who have been home educating for years. If necessary, we will this time include seminars on the impact of ContactPoint and the Badman Report and any government legislation that might have followed it. On Saturday afternoon, you will be free to visit the locality, use some of the on-site facilities, browse the resources or just talk to other Christian home educating families.

## ✳ **Accommodation**

Cefn Lea Conference centre lies in the beautiful and peaceful hills of Mid-Wales near the village of Dolfor, Powys. Accommodation for families is in mobile homes or shared, centrally heated chalets. There is an extra charge if you book one of the rooms with ensuite facilities. Camping and caravanning pitches are also available. The facilities at the centre include a pitch and putt course, tennis courts and a large children's play area. Indoors there are sports halls and board games for the less energetic.

## ✳ **Children**

Our conferences have been highly memorable for the children as well as the adults. However, because of the large number of children now coming to our conferences, every parent will be expected to spend one session helping with the children's programme. We will also have to limit the total number of children on the site. A supervised room where parents can take under-fives will be available during the plenary and seminar sessions but not in the evenings.

## ✳ **Resources**

A large conference room will be given over to people selling books and other materials relating to home education. Here you can browse and discuss items on sale with the vendors themselves. All tables except those set aside for second hand goods must be booked in advance on the application form.

## ✳ Cost

The cost of half board for the weekend conference including meals and accommodation is

Ensuite rooms are 20% extra. For self-caterers the cost is
